## Directions to Marrapatta Memorial Outdoor Education Centre

1194 Yabba Creek Road, Imbil

- a) Follow the Bruce Highway north (approximately 140 km).
- b) Stay on the highway until after Cooroy and Pomona.
- c) Take Exit 244 off the Bruce Highway to Lake Borumba, Mary Valley Tourist Drive. This is the old Bruce Highway. IMBIL turnoff. Turn left at the give way sign at the bottom of the ramp.
- d) Travel approximately 4.5 km take the Imbil/Lake Borumba turn off on your left. This is the Kenilworth – Skyring Creek Road. Follow this for 5.8 km and turn right onto Tuchekei Road.
- e) Follow Tuchekei Road over the Mary River for 4.7 km until the ‘T’ intersection.
- f) Turn left onto Mary Valley Road and follow this for approximately 4.6 km and turn right at the Imbil sign.
- g) From here it is approximately 11.94 km to Marrapatta.
- h) Follow the road through the township of Imbil, over the railway line and past the supermarket. This road crosses Yabba Creek a number of times before ending at Borumba Dam.
- i) Every time that the road crosses Yabba Creek it is sign posted – e.g. Yabba Creek Crossing No. 1 etc. Marrapatta is located between No. 5 and 6 crossings on the right hand side of the road.
- j) After crossing number five you will see the Borumba Deer Park turn off on the left, continue another 400m to the “Marrapatta” entrance. A brown letterbox marked 1194 indicates the centre’s entrance. You will then see a sign posted at the front gate and a bitumen driveway leading up to the buildings.

Approximate travelling time from Girls Grammar is 2 hours and 15 minutes.
