BGS and BGGS students must:

- Treat other people and their possessions with respect
- Follow the bus driver's directions without argument
- Never interfere with buses, shelters or signs by marking or damaging them in any way
- Wait for buses well back from the curb until the bus stops
- Allow other passengers to leave before boarding
- Never push other people waiting in line
- Sit properly on a seat if one is available and wear the seat belt provided
- Store school bags under the seat or in the appropriate luggage area
- Speak quietly and not create unnecessary noise
- Never bully or harass other students or the driver
- Never place feet on seats
- Never fight or use offensive language
- Never throw any items inside or from the buses
- Never consume food or drink or play loud music
- Never allow any portion of their body to protrude out of bus windows
- Never stand in front of the frontmost passenger seat
- Never use mobile phones to send harrassing or threatening messages, or photograph others without consent
- Wait until the bus stops before standing to exit
- Exit from the bus in a quiet and orderly fashion
- Never cross the road in front of the bus
- Use crossings or traffic lights if available
- In the event of an emergency or a breakdown, wait in the area indicated by the driver
